Title:	Pāṇinian Grammar

Course Content:

The format of *śāivasūtra* – Aphorisms on *sañjñānāma*, Primary combined rules, Aphorisms related to *Svarantha* noun declension, Formation of roots, Ten groups of roots, *ātmanepada* – *parasmaipada*. Phonetic Introduction, Euphonic Combination, Conjugation, Indeclinable Words, Nominal Stem formation and Compounds.

Methodology:

Lectures, discussions, visual aids and presentations.

Scheme of Assessment:

Assignments, classroom tests, oral presentations and end of the semester examinations. (For written examination 60%, for assignments, Presentation, in class tests 40%)
