Special attention will be paid to the salient features of the works of Subandhu, Dandin and Bana Bhatta, and the contribution of the prose medium to the development of the Sanskrit fiction. (iii) <i>Harsacarita, Ucch vasa</i> 1. (iv) <i>Nalacampu</i> (selected portions).
