- 2. Duration:** One year, 4 compulsory course units, 30 credits
- 3. Admission Requirements:**
 - (a) Completion of grade 9 or equivalent.
- 4. Aims and objectives:**
 - a) The main aim is to prepare foreign workers and non-Sinhalese Sri Lankans to function in a Sinhala speaking environment.
 - b) To equip them with an adequate knowledge of the important features of the Sinhala writing system.
- 5. Learning Outcomes:** On completion of this course, students will be able to:
 - practice simple language structures
 - relate everyday experiences
 - describe simple procedures
 - identify and practice politeness markers
 - describe people and places
 - explain simple procedures
 - express opinions politely
 - recall and restate memorable events
 - a) Students will gain proficiency in the general Sinhala writing system.
- 6. Teaching Methodology**
 - a) Lectures [15 hours per week throughout 24 weeks]
 - b) Audio-visual technology where appropriate
