Diploma in Translation and Interpretation Calling for Applications - 2025/2026

Applications for the entry of the above diploma will be entertained by the Department of Linguistics from 31 August 2025 to 30 September 2025.

This course has been designed to provide the candidates with theoretical knowledge and practice in translation and interpretation.

Course Structure:

I Tamil-Sinhalese translation (for candidates who are proficient skills in Sinhalese and Tamil) II English-Sinhalese translation (for candidates who have skills in English and Sinhalese)

Course Duration: One academic year. Lectures will be held every Saturday from 9.00 am to 4.00 pm at the university premises (onsite), with some online lectures.

Course Fee: 75,000 LKR (seventy-five thousand rupees)

The first instalment of 45,000 LKR (forty-five thousand rupees) should be made at the time of registration, and the second instalment of 30,000 LKR (thirty thousand rupees) should be made within three months from registration.

Minimum Entry Requirements: Passing the G.C.E. (A/L) exam

or equivalent qualifications

or relevant professional experience of 10 years, as required

Commencement: November 2025

Application Fee: The application fee of 750 LKR should be paid to the account number displayed in the receipt generated after completing the online application.

Submitting the Fill **Application:** out the online application available https://hu.kln.ac.lk/depts/linguistics, and send a printed copy together with the receipt issued by People's Bank upon the payment of the application fee, and copies of the birth certificate, NIC, and A/L result sheet, to reach The Coordinator, Diploma in Translation and Interpretation, Department of Linguistics, University of Kelaniya, No. 218 Kandy Road, Dalugama, Kelaniya 11600 on or before 30 September 2025, indicating Application of Diploma in Translation and Interpretation - 2025/2026 at the top left-hand corner of the envelope:
